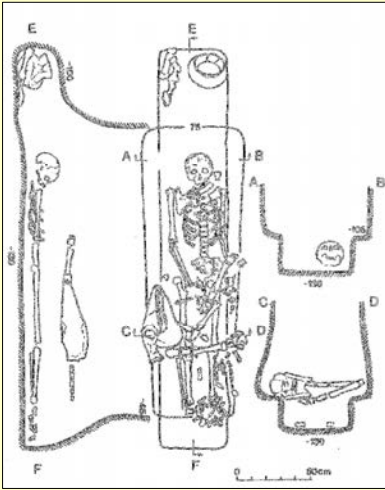

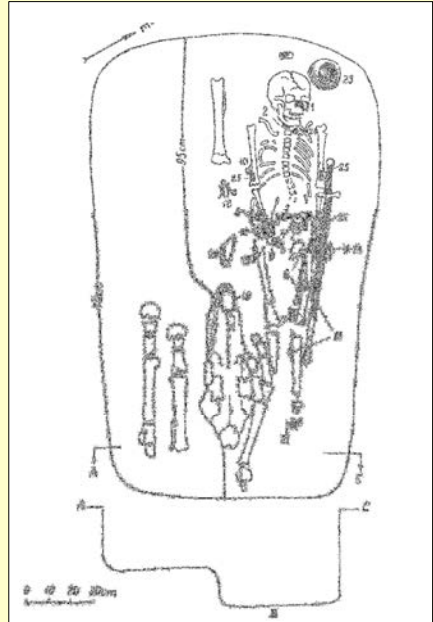

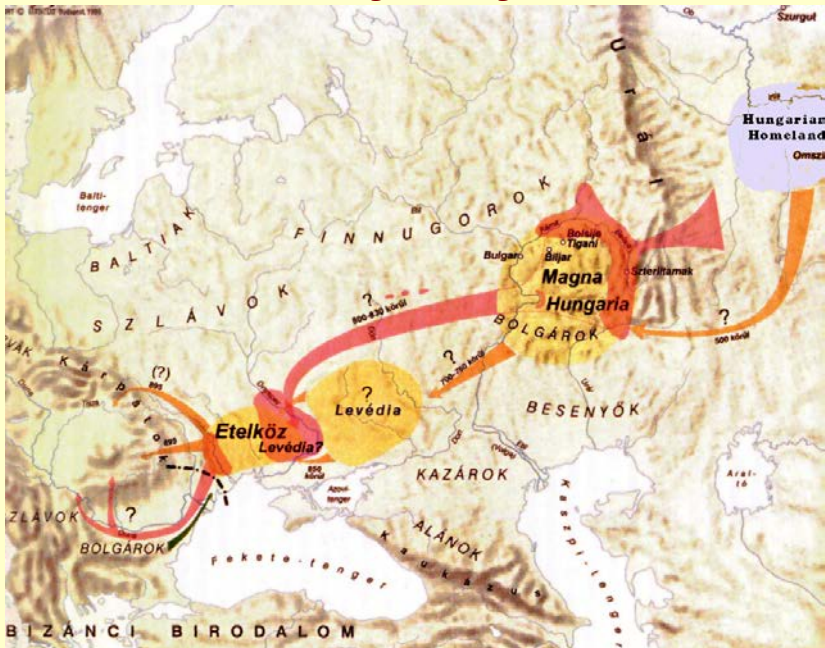

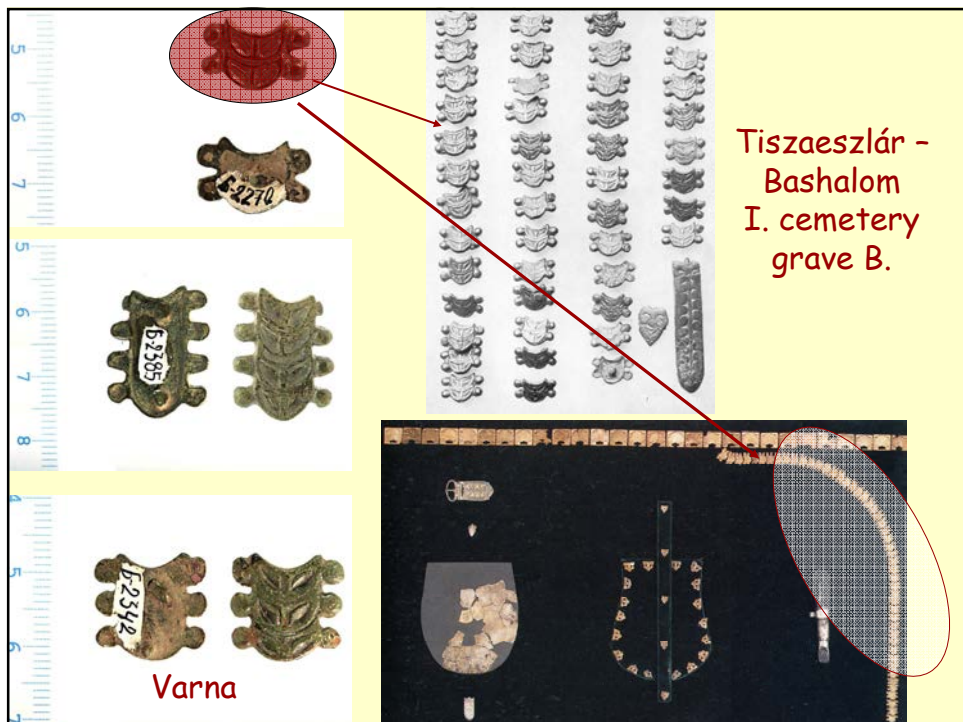

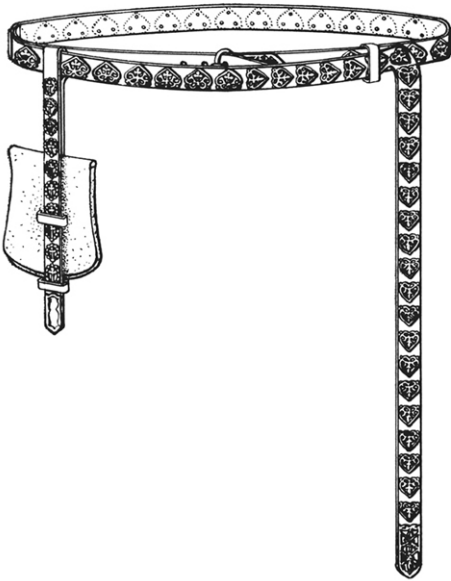

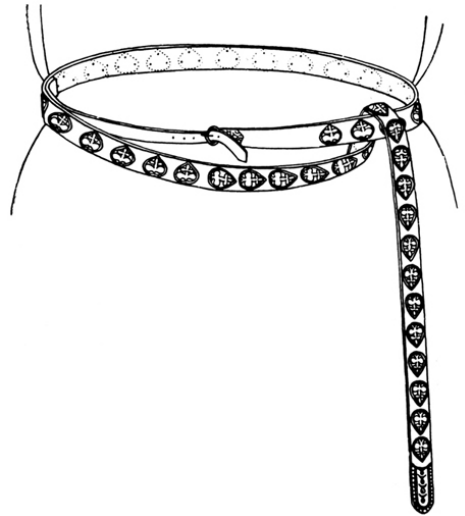


„Hungarian belt” from Krivina



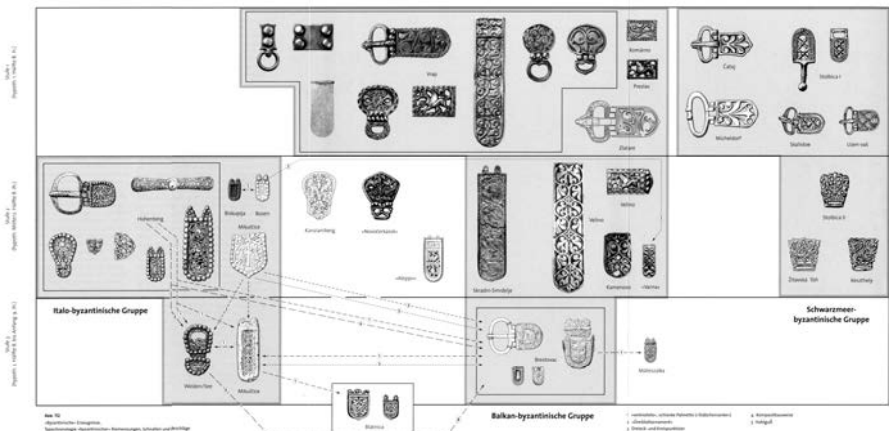


Inner fastening strap

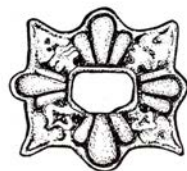
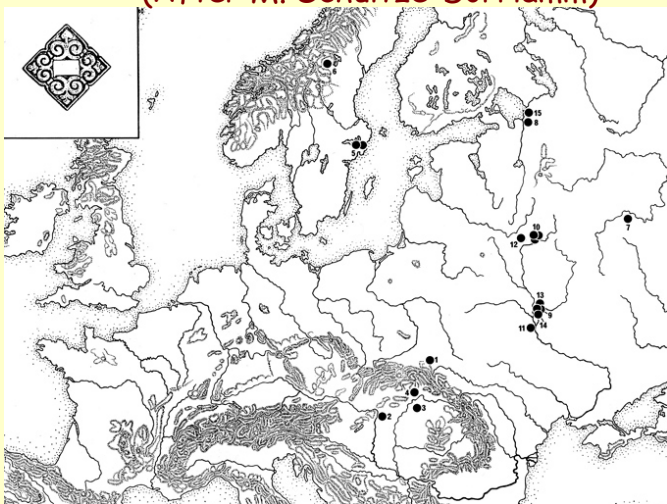

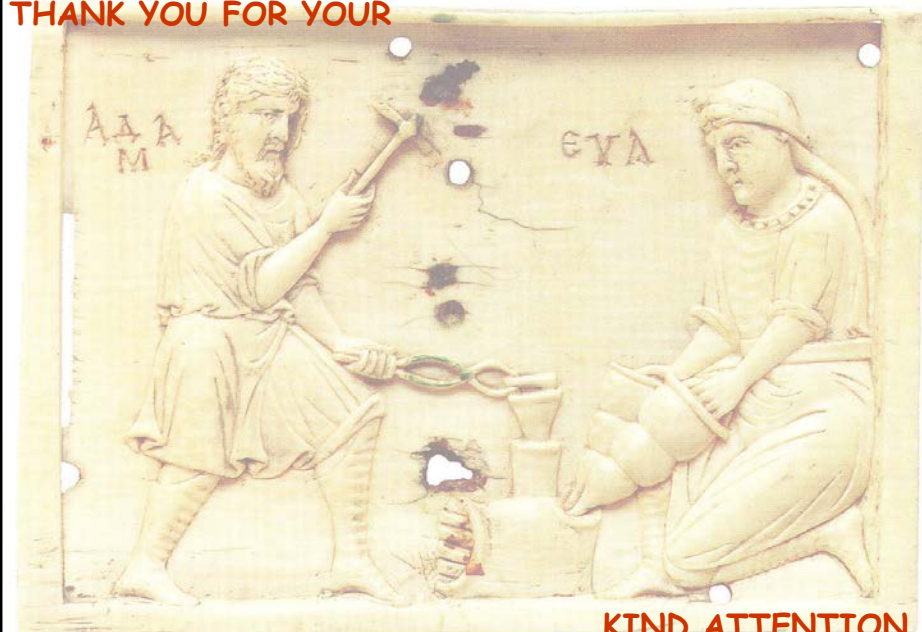


Sabre-tache with mounts
